TEACHERS' SALARIES (MATERNITY ABSENCE) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1987

1. The Department wishes to draw attention to the Teachers' Salaries (Maternity Absence) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987 (SR 1987 No 206).
2. These regulations revoke and replace the Teachers' Salaries (Maternity Absence) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980 (SR 1980 No 306).
3. The regulations continue the arrangements for payment to certain teachers during leave of absence due to pregnancy. In addition they provide that, where appropriate, payment made during such absence shall not be less than the amount of statutory maternity pay payable under the Social Security (Northern Ireland) Order 1986.
4. Any payment made under the regulations will go towards discharging any liability of the employing authority to pay statutory maternity pay.

6. This Circular is issued for general guidance only and is not meant to explain in detail the provisions of the regulations.
