**ACTING ALLOWANCES
TEACHERS' ABSENCES NOT EXCEEDING THREE WORKING DAYS
LEAVE OF ABSENCE FOR ADOPTIVE MOTHERS**

1. The Teachers' Salaries and Conditions of Service Committee (Schools) and the Further Education Negotiating Committee have agreed modifications to agreements on teachers' absences not exceeding three working days and leave of absence for adoptive mothers. The Teachers' Salaries and Conditions of Service Committee (Schools) has also agreed a modification to the agreement on acting allowances.

2. **ACTING ALLOWANCES:**

CIRCULAR NO 1990/25 - Paragraph 6

With effect from 1 August 1991 a teacher appointed in an acting capacity other than as a principal or vice-principal, must be in attendance in that capacity for 40 consecutive working days before qualifying for payment of an acting allowance.

4. **LEAVE OF ABSENCE FOR ADOPTIVE MOTHERS:**

With effect from the date of this Circular adoptive mothers may be granted leave of absence for a period not exceeding 29 weeks, the first 12 weeks of which shall be on half pay and the remainder on no pay.
