Dear Principal

Beidh tú eolach ar an chlúdach a thug na meáin le déanaí maidir leis an druga 'mephedrone' agus go háirithe ar na hiarmhairtí tromchúiseacha a bhaineann lena úsáid. Tá a fhios agam go dtuigeann tú go maith an ról ríthábhachtach a imríonn scoileanna maidir le hoideachas a thabhairt do pháistí agus do dhaoine óga ar na hiarmhairtí a bhaineann le substaintí dleathacha agus mídhleathacha agus ar na hiarmhairtí tromchúiseacha a bhaineann le mí-úsáid agus tá mé buíoch as do chuid tacaíochta le dul i ngleic leis an cheist thábhachtach seo.

You will all be aware of the recent media coverage in relation to the drug 'mephedrone' and in particular of the serious consequences of its use. I know that you appreciate the vital role schools play in educating our children and young people on the effects of both legal and illegal substances and of the terrible consequences of misuse and I am grateful for your support in tackling this important issue.

Ní léiríonn an treoir seo na hathruithe ar fad sa reachtaíocht a tugadh isteach ón bhliain 2004 agus i réimsí eile. Tá feidhm ag na prionsabail ghinearálta go fóill, áfach.

Ba mhaith liom buíochas a thabhairt duit as do chuid iarrachtaí ar fad go dtí seo maidir le hoideachas ar dhruaí i scoileanna. Iarraim ort leanúint de bheith ag soláthar cláir éifeachtaigh oideachais ar dhruaí trí choinneáil ar an eolas sa timpeallacht atá ag athrú.

Tá mé ag cur leis seo, liosta de láithreáin ghréasáin agus teagmhálaithe gutháin úsáideacha mar eolas duit.

However, in more general terms, it is important that schools continue to deliver an effective drugs education programme and respond to incidents and emerging issues. Therefore I would like to remind you that your school must have an up to date drugs policy and that it is strongly recommended that you designate a senior member of staff as having overarching responsibility for drugs. I recommend that you refer to DE Circular 2004/9 and the supporting CCEA guidance 'drugs: guidance for schools'
