## ENROLMENTS AT SCHOOLS AND IN FUNDED PRE-SCHOOL EDUCATION IN NORTHERN IRELAND 2008/09

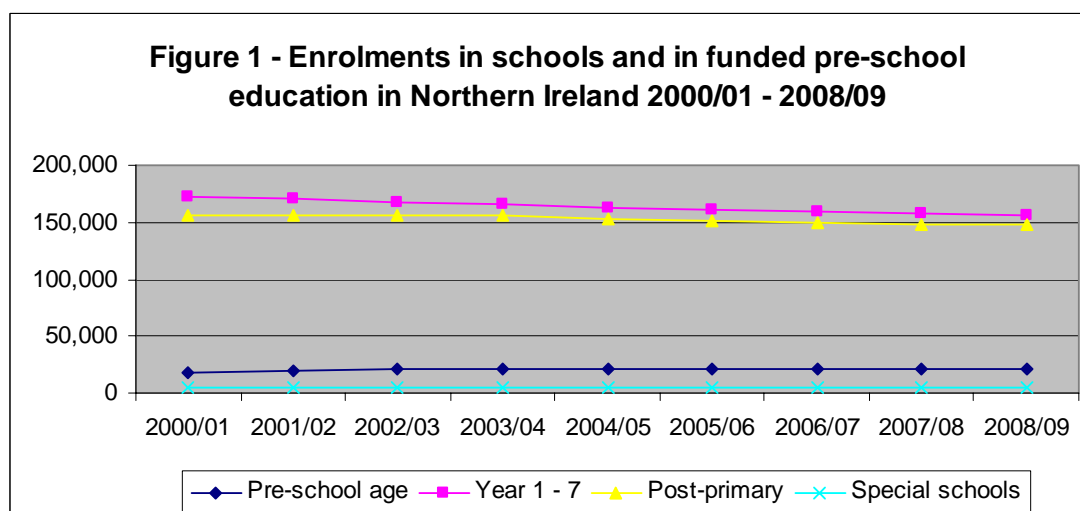
### Key points

#### ***Funded pre-school education***

- There are 21,289 children in funded pre-school education: 14,080 in nursery schools or nursery classes in primary schools; 606 in reception classes/groups; and 6,603 in funded places in voluntary and private pre-school education centres. In 2003/04 there were 20,971 children in funded pre-school education.
- The reported religion of children in pre-school education is: 47.9% Roman Catholic, 32.5% Protestant, 2.8% Other Christian, 0.7% Non Christian, and 16.1% Other/No Religion/Not recorded.

#### ***Grant-aided Schools***

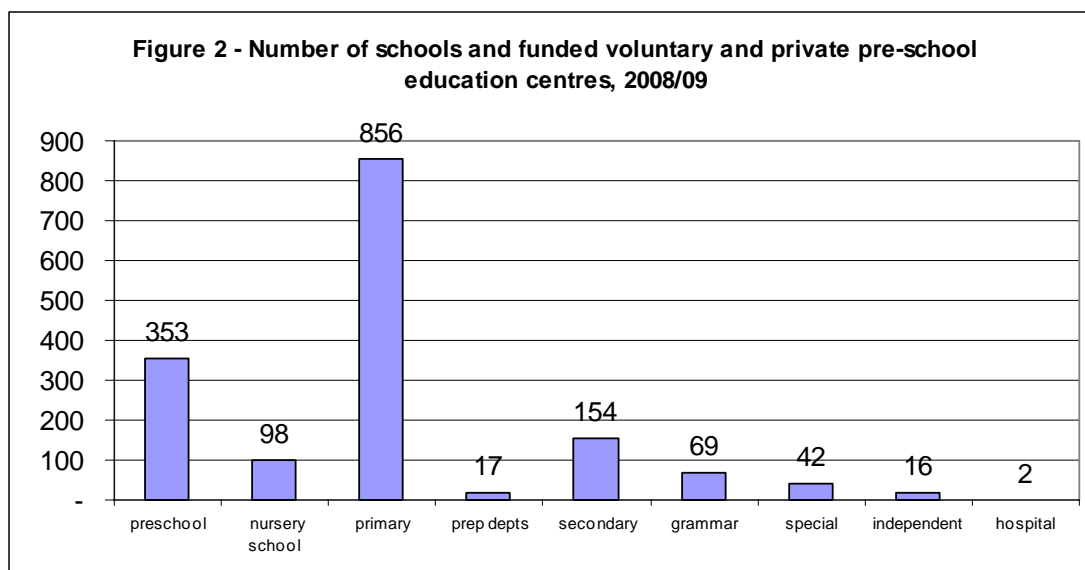
- There are 155,994 pupils in primary schools and preparatory departments (Years 1 – 7). In 2003/04 the figure was 165,347.
- There are 147,986 pupils in post-primary schools (Years 8 – 14). In 2003/04 the figure was 155,394.



## Key points, continued

### Grant-aided Schools

- Some 19,386 pupils (6.1%) of the total enrolment in nursery, primary and post-primary schools attend integrated schools. In 2003/04, enrolment at integrated schools was 16,494 (4.9%) of total enrolment.
- Some 2,730 (0.8%) pupils attend Irish medium schools, with a further 766 pupils attending Irish medium units attached to English medium schools. In 2003/04, there were 2,143 (0.6%) attending Irish medium schools with a further 475 pupils in Irish medium units attached to English medium schools.
- In the post-primary phase, 62,410 pupils (42.2%) attend grammar schools. In 2003/04, the number was 63,347 (40.8%).
- Some 17.6% of P1 – P7 pupils in primary schools and preparatory departments are entitled to free school meals, as are 24.4% of pupils in secondary (non-grammar) schools and 5.6% of grammar school pupils.
- The reported religion of pupils in schools is: 50.7% Roman Catholic, 38.1% Protestant, 2.4% Other Christian, 0.4% Non Christian, and 8.3% Other/No Religion/Not recorded.
- The reported ethnicity of pupils is 97.7% white (excluding Irish travellers), with 2.3% pupils of mixed or minority ethnic groups.
- Some 18.6% of pupils in schools were recorded as having special education needs; 4.1% of pupils had a statement of special educational needs.
- The average number of pupils per class in primary schools (year 1 – year 7) was 22.

4. The statistics in this press release have been derived from the annual School Census; details about the survey may be found at <http://www.statistics.gov.uk/STATBASE/Source.asp?vlnk=1028&More=Y>. For pre-school centres and nursery schools the Census consists of a paper return comprising a number of tables; for primary, special and post-primary schools, it consists of a return comprising anonymised individual pupil records, made by Electronic Data Interchange.
5. The 2008/09 figures in this press release are based on information as at 10th October 2008.
6. The figures for nursery *classes* relate to approved nursery classes in primary schools. The figures for reception refer to pupils who were below compulsory school age at 1 July 2008, who were admitted to a reception class or group in primary school following their 4<sup>th</sup> birthday. Schools may admit reception pupils throughout the year, but only those who have been admitted by 31 October are counted in the school census.
