Clearly drawn to an ordnance scale not smaller than 1/2500. 2. Site outlined in red. 3. Area of site. 4. Cardinal points. 5. Scale. 6. Gradients, if any indicated (<i>eg 1 in 50</i>). 7. Main roads (<i>indicate road widths</i>) giving distance to nearest town or village and any important identification features. 8. Position of available main sewers or, where sewers are not available, alternate arrangements. 9. Source of proposed water supply. 10. Nearest supply of electricity. 11. Position of buildings, if any, adjoining the site. 12. Position of any trees or group of trees which should be retained for their beauty or for their usefulness as a wind screen or likely to be retained at the request of the planning authority. 13. Position of sight lines likely to be requested by the planning authority. 14. Position of building lines likely to be requested by the planning authority. 15. Positions of any underground services on site which may affect development of the land.
