DETERMINATION

In accordance with the provisions of Article 69(1) and (6) of the Education and Libraries (Northern Ireland) Order 1986, the Department of Education has determined that with effect from 1 September 2011 the annual salary to be paid to prematurely retired teachers who are re-employed in grant-aided schools shall be Point 1 of the teachers Main Pay Scale.

For the purpose of this determination a prematurely retired teacher is defined as a teacher who has been granted premature retirement on grounds of redundancy or in the interest of the efficient discharge of the employers function and who has received discretionary compensation in the form of an additional service credit ("added years").

This Determination does not apply to re-employed prematurely retired teachers who immediately before 1 September 2011 were employed under a permanent or fixed term contract for so long as they remain employed under that contract.
